Higher Education towards Sustainable Development: Making Universities Lighthouses of Sustainability

Higher Education throughout the world is linked to the future of a country and the society, and contributes to the shaping of the predominant culture, from grassroots to the leadership. Sustainable Development (SD) cannot be rooted at local, national, regional and global level if Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) do not fully embrace the SD principles, practices and attitudes. This is done by considering the SDGs as essential elements for the curriculum, practices, governance and relationship of HEIs with the society. The above could be operationalized through the Whole Institution Approach (WIA). WIA is a priority action area within the UNESCO global framework ESDfor2030; it is a key strand of the Framework for the implementation of the UNECE Strategy for ESD from 2021 to 2030; and a major priority field in the revised Action Plan towards 2030 of the Mediterranean Strategy for ESD. The last few years several interesting programmes and initiatives on applying WIA tools and practices in Higher Education Institutions have been suggested and undertaken by specific universities wishing to become beacons of sustainability. The Greek Universities have embarked into the SD areas already since 2011 by adopting a "Sustainability Charter". Recently there was a major revision of the Charter which offers a potential example for others to be inspired by. The side event will provide the opportunity to discuss the upscaling of such initiatives, and how Higher Education Institutions can be stimulated in embracing and implementing a Whole Institution Approach; to highlight best practices at institutional and operational level that can be replicated; and, to identify challenges and ways to overcome them concerning ESD in the Higher Education sector.
